The premature death of a rising professional

Failing to combat a massive heart attack, Mr. Mir Mostafa Kamal, PEng., Director, River Engineering Division IWM passed away on 08 August 2020 at his residence at around 02:30 AM. He was born on 20 January 1966 at Jugia in Kushtia to Mr. Mir Motasem Ali and Ms. Sufia Akter. Mr Kamal did his B.Sc. in Civil Engineering from BUET in 1989 and M.Sc in the same discipline in 1996. He was an extraordinary brilliant student and this was reflected in his professional career at IWM.

Mr. Kamal joined IWM on 01 December 1990. His service was regularized in April 1997. He served IWM for 29 years. He was serving as Director of River Engineering Division since November 2009. Since joining IWM, Mr. Kamal had been extensively trained in Mathematical Modelling at home and abroad and developed himself as a key resource of the Institute with high level of expertise in the field of mathematical modelling and computational hydraulics. He managed and supervised a significant number of nationally important projects in water resource management. He was a Member of the Institution of Engineers, Bangladesh (IEB), and registered as a Professional Engineer (PEng.).

He was wise beyond his education and age, people of all ages and stations benefited from his counsel mainly in his field of expertise. He will be remembered for his unfailing work ethics, honesty and integrity.

At the time of his death, Mr. Kamal left behind a lovely family, his wife, a daughter and two sons. His death is an irreparable loss for the Institute and the Engineering community in Bangladesh as well.
